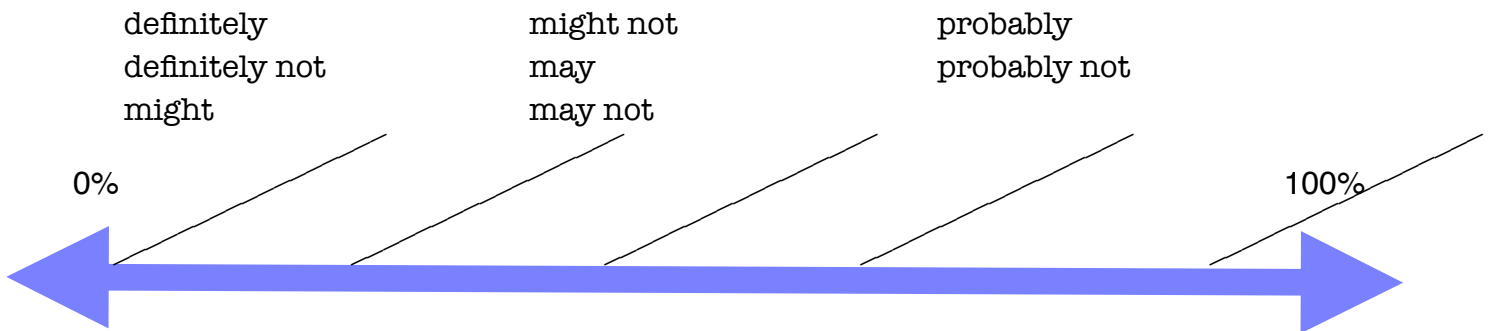


Language Focus
